International Access Scholarship	The International Access Scholarship is a common scholarship application for the following awards: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Need-based financial aid recipients with a minimum institutional GPA of 2.75 for undergraduates and 3.2 for graduate students. ▪ First-generation college students (defined as neither your mother nor father graduated from a 4-year institution); there is no GPA requirement for the first-generation award. ▪ First-semester graduate students must upload a copy of their final undergraduate transcript and meet the 3.2 GPA eligibility requirement 	Maymester/Summer 2018: February 15th Fall 2018: April 13th Spring 2019: October 15th
